The Board of Directors of Texas Future Business Leaders of America is to establish policy and long-range plans for the organization. The Board consists of one elected adviser from each Area, and two business representatives. The State Chairman, State Adviser, State Officer Coordinator, current student State President, and the Middle Level Representative shall be ex-officio, non-voting members of the Board.

The Board shall meet twice a year, usually at the Career and Technology Education Conference each summer and at the Mid-Year Planning Meeting. Additional meetings may be called as necessary.

This is not an intense, time-consuming position as Board members are to set policy, not administer the daily operations of the organization. However, most Board members are active in the organization and see their position as a unique learning experience!

Elections will be held on the second day of the SLC high school chapter may cast one vote for an area representative position and one for the Business Representative. Middle Level chapters may cast one vote for the middle level representative. Only advisers will vote. Election is by a simple majority.

- Have the desire and commitment to seek the best for the organization and its members
- Be willing to devote time to the organization
- Be willing to attend and participate in all called Board Meetings
- Have access to email as most communications are conducted via email

Business Representative Qualifications:

- May serve two four-year consecutive terms
